Essential Questions:	What are the drawbacks of prejudice and the positive aspects of diversity?	
Sponge Activity:	<b>Journal Writing Topic</b> - Are you prejudiced and whom are you prejudiced against?	
Activating Prior Knowledge:	Review discussion of Chapter 1.	
Vocabulary Development:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Display terms</b> - hostile, incapable, assure, intimidate, emulate, bravo, punctual</li> <li>• Have students complete vocabulary graphic organizer From "New to Known" for words</li> </ul>	
Skill Lesson Through Direct Instruction and Modeling:	Review Paired Reading. Use the <a href="#">Modified Double Sided Journal Entry</a> for entries and summarizing.	
Active Literacy:	Students read <a href="#">Chapter 2</a> in pairs, completing Double Entry Journal as they read.	
Post Literacy:	Partner sets or small group- discussion of Modified Double Sided Journal Entry.	
Reflection:	<b>Exit slip</b> - Have each student complete exit slip with one thing he/she learned from vocabulary, video clip, or reading.
