Review Exit slips from prior day.
 Display terms - desperate, reinforcements, radioactive, pliers, zombie, hypnotized, frostbite Have students complete vocabulary graphic organizer <u>Frayer Model</u> for vocabulary words - Teacher chooses 1 or two words as a model of how the students are to complete the graphic organizer.
Teacher model of correct sentence structure and grammar versus spoken language material, as this book is written. Take one or more sentences from text, write on board and use editing marks in preparation to rewrite.
Students read Chapters 3 and 4 in independently, completing <u>Double Entry Journal</u> as they read.
